

## European Day of Languages 2024

### Some possible activities:

- 1. Build the Brandenburg Gate / Eiffel Tower / Sagrada Familia** – pupils build these icons monuments out of sustainable products (toilet rolls, unwanted food packaging, anything cheap / free etc). Best one wins a prize and certificate.
- 2. Bake off** – pupils bake a cake / decorate a cake with a European theme. They would also bake a European recipe. Use Great British Bake-off masks for the judges to wear. Best one wins a prize and certificate.
- 3. Flags** – Colour in the [European flags](#) and hang them on a ‘washing line’ in the classroom
- 4. Talk to me quiz** – staff wear a [badge](#) with “talk to me in different languages and the pupils have to complete the [quiz sheet](#) to guess the language on the teacher’s badge. Staff sign-up sheet [here](#).
